## CLOTHING

- Breathable cotton or linen layers (light colors)
- Light scarf or dupatta — sun, dust & temple modesty
- Warm shawl or light jacket for cold desert nights
- Knee-covering bottoms for temple & fort visits
- One smart-casual outfit for heritage hotel dinners
- Swimwear for hotel pools
- Wide-brim hat or cap

## FOOTWEAR & ACCESSORIES

- Closed walking shoes for forts & uneven stone steps
- Easy slip-on sandals — shoes come off often at temples
- UV-protection sunglasses
- Reusable water bottle
- Lightweight crossbody or day bag

## HEALTH & COMFORT

- Sunscreen SPF 50+ and lip balm with SPF
- Hand sanitizer & wet wipes
- Electrolyte sachets / rehydration salts
- Personal medication + a basic first-aid kit
- Dust mask for open-jeep or train travel

## DOCUMENTS & TECH

- Passport + visa copy (digital and printed)
- Travel insurance details
- Hotel & itinerary confirmations
- Portable charger / power bank
- Universal plug adapter (India: Type C/D/M)

Best packed for: Oct–Mar (cool, ideal touring weather — nights can drop near freezing in the desert) and Apr–Jun (very hot days, light fabrics essential).
